

Pass My Physical OSA Screen Algorithm

Determine if Tx is Required

Tx Not Required

Treatment not required if driver's AHI is ≤ 15 , unless the driver has comorbidity such as type 2 diabetes, untreated HTN or hypothyroidism, or CVD or artery disease.

When comorbidity is present, and the driver's AHI is less than 15 but more than 5, the driver should be considered for required Tx. CMEs should consult with the sleep specialist. Driver's with a diagnosis of OSA (AHI ≥ 5) can be certified for 1 year.

Tx Required

Treatment is required whenever the OSA test results indicate an AHI of 15 or greater. The driver can be issued a 3 month certificate to become compliant.

When the driver is compliant and treatment is shown to be effective, the CME can issue a 1 year
